

## A Thrasher Family Genealogical Update

Much information has been published over time concerning the DNA related Thrasher families beginning with John & Ruth Cloud Thrasher. The best references, other than the material that has been published in the Thrasher Family Association's Newsletter since 1983, are 1. "Our Thrasher Heritage" compiled by Dorothy S. Pruett, 1986 & 2. "Thrasher-Barton Descendants in Georgia" compiled by Vessie Thrasher Rainer, 1977.

Many descendants of two of John & Ruth Cloud Thrasher's children, Isaac (married Ruth Barton) and John (married Susan Barton) have matching DNA so we know these family lines are the same family.

To avoid lots of repetition, this update begins with Isaac's son, John C. Thrasher. A large portion of the genealogy has already appeared in the TFA Newsletters. These are the March 2009 issue and the December 2010 issue and were submitted by William Boyd and Robert P. Thrasher. Helen Thrasher Long has made her excellent genealogy of this branch of the Thrashers available through the Alabama US Genweb site.

This update includes very recent research and includes the family of Annette Thrasher Aspinwall, a TFA member as well as Annette's cousin Mary Ann Thrasher Mitchell.

13. John Lanman

Son of James Lanman, the Revolutionary War soldier, John was born May 30, 1783, in Caswell County, North Carolina. He and Martha Thrasher were married March 3, 1808, in Breckenridge County, Kentucky. She was born March 9, 1788, in Bedford County, Virginia, the daughter of Thomas (John?) Thrasher and Elizabeth Tutterer.

**CHALLENGE**

John Lanman and Martha, his wife, whose maiden name was Thrasher, now living in Leopold Township, Perry County, Indiana, have certainly followed the scriptural injunction to multiply and replenish the earth.

John Lanman was born in Caswell County, North Carolina, May 30, 1783, and his wife, Daughter of Thomas Thrasher, was born in Bedford County, Virginia, near Bull Run Battlegrounds, March 9, 1788, and they are, consequently, aged 88 and 83 respectively. They were married in Breckenridge County, Kentucky, March 3, 1808, and moved to Perry County, Indiana, in 1811 before the Battle of Tippecanoe and paid taxes to the Sheriff at Vincennes when this was a portion of Knox County.

They have been members of the Baptist Church for 50 years and now have living 198 children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren, and 45 dead, making a total of living and dead of 243. If there has ever been a single one of the family had a law suit or been arrested for an offense, it is not known to this subscriber who is the father of ten of the living and one of the dead grandchildren. I would ask what county or state can beat this?

Abraham Howe

Abraham Howe, who married the daughter Nancy, states in the letter above that John and Martha Lanman moved to Perry County, Indiana, in 1811; but David Sodrel shows that their first four children were born in Kentucky. He lists George, the fifth child, as the first born in Indiana, on October 6, 1815. So it is quite probable that they moved to Indiana in 1815 rather than in 1811.

Both John and Martha died three years after this letter was published, Martha on January 26, 1874, and John on March 13 of the same year.

They had 14 children, and all the children who married apparently married in Perry County. They are listed as follows:

### Martha Thrasher

Martha Thrasher, wife of John Lanman (13), was the descendant of settlers in colonial Pennsylvania and Maryland. She was born on March 9, 1788, in Bedford County, Virginia, the daughter of John Thrasher and Elizabeth Dutrow. The parents were issued a license to marry in Frederick County, Maryland; the names listed were John Thrasher and Elizabeth Tutterer. They were married on September 29, 1783. Elizabeth died in about 1818, probably in Breckinridge County, Kentucky, or Perry County, Indiana, as they had gone to Breckinridge County from Virginia in 1806. John died in about 1828, but again, the exact location of his death is unknown.

John Thrasher had purchased land from his sister, Sarah Thrasher Hook, in Bedford County, Virginia, in 1790. They were the children of Thomas Thrasher, who died in 1804 in Frederick County. His will, recorded on June 12, 1804, names his eight children. He was married to Martha Lee in 1748. Thomas was born on October 28, 1725 (O.S.), and Martha was born on April 21, 1729 (O.S.) Martha Lee Thrasher died in 1806. Their eight children:

Martha Lee Thrasher was the daughter of James and Mary Lee of Frederick County, Maryland. Thomas Thrasher was born in 1725, the son of Benjamin Thrasher and his wife, Mary. Benjamin Thrasher was listed in the records of Rock Creek Parish, Prince George's County, Maryland, on September 18, 1719 (O.S.), as a subscriber to the construction of a new chapel there. He purchased "The Benjamin," his home, on June 9, 1726 (O.S.) from John Beal (located in Frederick County). He died in 1740, leaving his estate to his wife, Mary. She in turn completed a deed of gift to her children on March 21, 1742 (O.S.) Their children:
